The North Hills Sports Car Club begins our 2025 season with **Intro to Autocross**, a non-competitive event designed for anyone interested in getting started in the sport of autocross. Club Members will teach you everything you need - from preparing your car to learning the line to driving the course - in a safe, stress-free environment. You'll get to know your fellow autocrossers, learn what a typical day is like, and hone your skills so you're ready to join us for our 2025 season.

In the morning, we cover the basics of participating in autocross with the NHSCC, including registration, work assignments, and a typical event day schedule. We will also cover the basics of autocross driving and how to improve your driving skills to make the most of your car's capabilities.

Then we move to car prep and tech inspection, ensuring your car is safe, prepared, and meets our competition requirements. We'll move to the course for a walk-through to teach the basics of choosing the right line and working the course during an event. Instructors will even take interested students on a ride of the course - at speed - to show them what to expect. A pizza lunch is included in your registration, a great time to get to know club members and ask questions.

Then it's time to drive!

An experienced club member will guide you through a typical autocross course, teaching you to navigate common elements. You will have multiple runs to practice and set a personal best time. You'll come away from the day ready to participate in autocross events confidently.

Introduction to Autocross is open to anyone. All you need is a street-legal vehicle and a Snell 2015 or newer helmet. The club has limited loaners available. You don't even need a sports car; your daily driver is most likely allowed. See the Club's website at www.nhsc.com for complete vehicle eligibility details and driver requirements.
